The concert on Friday, September 27, will be held at 7:30 at the University of the Incarnate Word. Composers are encouraged to provide their own performers, but compositions for voice(s), solo instruments, and/or chamber ensembles of up to 5 players will be considered for those who cannot provide performers.

There will be a Saturday morning or afternoon podium/poster session. The concert on Saturday, September 28, will be a special concert focused on art song and co-sponsored by the Composers Alliance of San Antonio and the Art Song Center for Poets and Musicians. For compositions, please submit a PDF of your full score AND a link to recording (on YouTube, Soundcloud, Google Drive, etc.; computer realizations acceptable). No parts need to be submitted at this time. For podium/poster presentations, please submit an abstract of no more than 250 words. All scores should be clearly labeled with the name of the composer.
